AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR RENEW THE RUMPKE ORIGINAL CONTRACT AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE 05-23 FOR ONE (1) ADDITIONAL YEAR TO FEBRUARY 28, 2027.

WHEREAS, Council entered into a contract with Rumpke of Ohio Inc for solid waste and recycling removal within the village; and

WHEREAS, the first additional extension of the contract expires on February 28, 2026, and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to extend the contract for one (1) additional year under the original terms and conditions, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. That the Mayor is hereafter authorized ^{to} notify Rumpke that the Village desires to extend the contract for one (1) additional year under the terms and conditions of the original contract.

Section 2. The village reserves the right to extend the contract for an additional year in 2027 under new legislation.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is declared an emergency, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety in that the expiration date of the current contract is February 28, 2026 and the village desires not to have a break in trash and recycling collections. This ordinance to be in full force and effect immediately upon passage.
